Section - B**4 × 10 = 40**

Note: Answer **any four** questions. Each question is of 10 marks and maximum word limit is 200 words.

- 4) How does the poet portray the dawn of true love in 'The Good Morrow'?
- 5) Write critical summary of 'On his 23rd Birthday'

- 7) Attempt a critical appreciation on William Blake's 'The Chimney Sweeper'.
- 8) Throw light on the reasons of Shylock hating Antonio.
- 9) Write a note on the nature of Shakespearean tragedy.
