- 4) Write the summary of 'Ozymandies.'
- 5) What does Hopkins wishes to convey through his poem 'God Grandeur'.
- 6) Critically appreciate the poem 'The world is too much with us.'
- 7) Write a note on the use of imagery in 'Hymn to the spirit of Nature.'
- 8) Discuss 'Frost At Midnight' as an autobiographical poem.
- 9) Throw light on the central idea of the poem 'Ode to Melancholy.'

(Long Answer Questions)

Note: Section 'C' will contain 4 (four) Long Answer Type Questions and each question will have an internal choice. Examinees will have to answer any two questions. Each question will be of 20 (twenty) marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 500 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 40 marks.

- 12) 'La Belle Dame Sans Merci' is a literary ballad, depicting love and doom. Elucidate.
