- (iv) Who is Alegernon's best friend?
- (v) Who was Sophocles referred to in the poem 'Doner Beach'?
- (vi) To whom is the poem 'The Deserted Village' dedicated to?

- (vii) Name the poem where in Browning pays tribute to his wife's memory.
- (viii) Who is Fra Pandolf?
- (ix) What figure of speech is in 'I wandered lonely as a cloud'.
- (x) What is the best reward for the lover in the poem 'Last Ride Together'?

Section - B

- 4) 'Pied Beauty' is a catalogue poem. Discuss.

- 6) How does Byron personify liberty in 'On the castle of Chillon'?
- 7) Why does Duke draw the attention of the listener to the bronze sculpture of Neptune taming a horse?
- 8) Critically appreciate the poem 'Spring and fall'.
- 9) Write the thematic summary of 'There be none of Beauty's Daughter'.

Section - C**2 × 20 = 40**

(Long Answer Questions)

Note: Section C will contain 4 (four) Long Answer Type Questions and each question will have an internal choice. Examinees will have to answer any 2 (two) questions. Each question will be of 20 (twenty) marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 500 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 40 marks.
