- (vi) What is the Mississippi River symbol of for Huck and Jim in 'The Adventures of Hurckleberry Finn'?
- (vii) Name the novel and the author that depicts the tragic life of a young black girl who wants nothing more than to be loved by her family and her schoolmates.
- (viii) 'I don't say he is a great man But he's a human being, and a terrible thing to happening to him He is not to be allowed to fall into his grave like a dog.' Who is talking to whom and about whom in this dialogue from the play 'Death of a salesman'?

- 6) Discuss 'When Lilacs Last in the Doory and Bloomed' as an elegy.

- 7) What elements of mysticism do you find in Emily Dickinson's poetry?
- 8) The attitudes of the poet and the tramps are contrasted in 'Two Tramps in Mud Time'. Discuss.
- 9) Discuss 'The Scarlet Letter' in the light of Hester's moral guilt.
