## Section - A

(Very Short Answer Questions)

**Note:** Section 'A' contains 8 (eight) very short answer type questions (one word, one sentence and definitional type). All questions in this section are compulsory. Each question will be of 2 marks and maximum word limit for each answer will be 30 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 16 marks.

- 1) (i) Who wrote 'Song of My Self'?
  - (ii) Who is more racked by guilt Hester or Dimmisdale?
  - (iii) Where does Tom work?
  - (iv) What colour is the throne in Emperor Jones?
  - (v) In "mending wall" what is there that does not love a wall?
  - (vi) Why does pecola stay briefly with the Mac teers?

- (vii) Before Henry heads off to the front at Pavla what does Catherine give him? (Farewell to Arms)
- (viii) Name the doctor in 'A small good thing'.

### Section - B

 $4 \times 8 = 32$ 

(Short Answer Questions)

**Note:** Section 'B' will contain 8 (eight) short answer type questions. Examinees will have to answer any 4 (four) questions. Each question will be of 8 (eight) marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 200 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 32 marks.

- 2) Which is the greater threat to children in The bluest Eye?
- 3) 'Farewell to Arms' is one of the most famous war novels ever written. Comment.
- 4) What is the 'Small good thing' referred in the title?
- 5) Write the theme of the poem stopping by the woods on a snowy evening.
- 6) Describe Emperor Jones appearance in the first scene.
- 7) How does Claudia initially react to the news about Mr Henry?
- 8) Distinguish between a scholar and book worm according to Emerson.
- 9) What role does the fear of abandonment play in Willy's life?

(Long Answer Questions)

**Note:** Section 'C' will contain 4 (four) long answer type questions and each question will have internal choice. Examinees will have to answer any 2 (two) questions. Each question will be of 16 marks and maximum word limit for each answer is 500 words. Maximum marks of this section will be 32 marks.

- 10) How does nature function in the novel the bluest eye? Is Morrison's use of natural imagery hopeful or ironic?
- 11) Compare and contrast Emily Dickenson's poems 'I heard a fly buzz when I died' and 'Because I could not stop for death'.
- 12) In both substance and style what is unique in Whitman's poetry?
- 13) Summarize the basic idea of Emerson's 'The American Scholar'.
